German Visa:

The organizers will provide a letter of recommendation to participants requiring a German visa. Please note that obtaining a valid German visa involves following the necessary procedures. For detailed information, please visit the official German Federal Foreign Office visa page:

Please be aware that the final decision to grant a German visa rests solely with the German authorities. Additionally, citizens of several nationalities may be eligible for visa-free entry or visas upon arrival, depending on Germany's immigration policies.

Accommodation (Berlin)

For those who will be travelling from outside Germany/Berlin, accommodation will be provided upon prior confirmation.

Travel and Health Insurance

Participants will solely be responsible to purchase any travel -related insurance, including medical insurance.

Conference Registration

The conference sessions and cultural evening will be accessible only to those with registration and confirmation prior to the event. There will be few conference passes available to members of the public. Please stay tuned in for how to register for these passes.

Meals

AISS will provide meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) during the conference. Please note that laundry, international calls and bar service will be on your own.

Conference ID Cards

Participants are requested to wear their ID cards to get access to the Conference venue and related events. The conference adopts a free seating practice except for our panelists.

Language Service

The conference language will be English.

Media

All discussions will be streamed live via AISS media platforms. Representatives from local, national, and international media will be accredited to cover the program. A separate registration form will be provided for international media in accordance with Germany's laws and regulations.

Weather

In Berlin, on March 23–24, 2026, you can expect cool early-spring weather. Average daytime temperatures typically reach around 11 °C, while nighttime lows drop to about 2 °C. Light rain and overcast skies are common during this time of year, so carrying a warm layer and an umbrella is advisable.
